Description:

The 33kW solar electric facility is attached to the 18 degree pitched roof of the school's bus maintenance facility. The system consists of 165 solar modules and one 30kW inverter which delivers electricity to the school's electrical grid, providing power to the entire campus where needed. The system generates over 50,000kWh of electricity annually.

The school avoids generating thousands of tons of harmful emissions such as carbon dioxide, nitrogen oxide and sulfur dioxide by purchasing the clean, renewable energy from this energy facility. This renewable energy facility is owned, operated and maintained by Island Pacific Energy and the power generated is sold to the school at a competitive rate.
